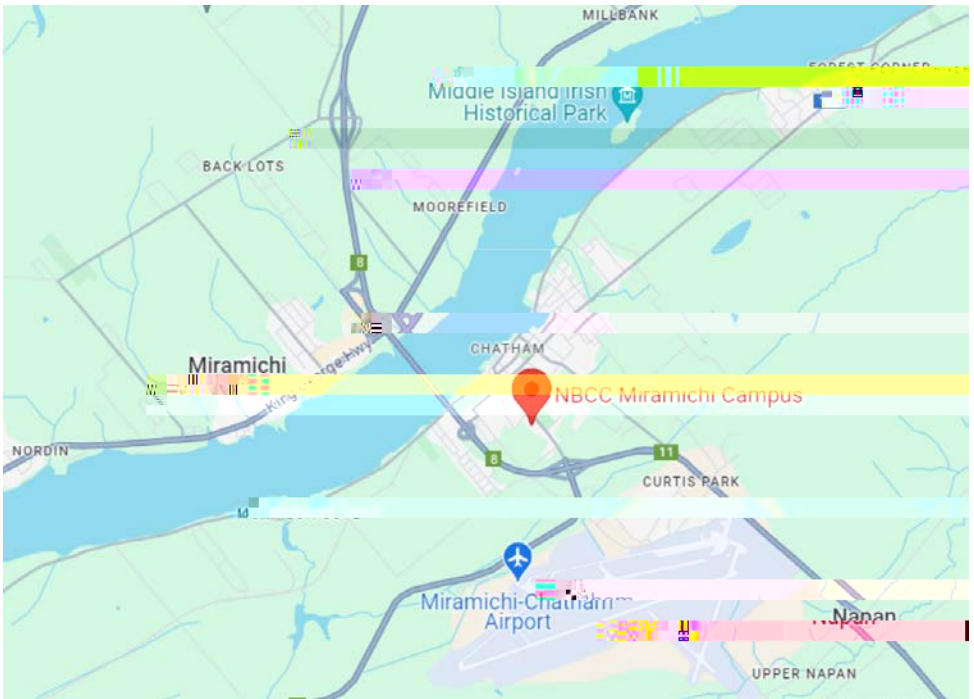

DECIDING WHERE TO LIVE

NBCC Miramichi is located at 80 University Ave. Miramichi, New Brunswick, Canada or “Miramichi East” (Former town of Chatham).

If you are intending on walking to college, you may want to focus your search in this area.

THINGS YOU SHOULD CONSIDER WHEN LOOKING FOR A PLACE TO RENT:

- Accessibility to public transit: <http://miramichitransit.ca/>
- Noise. Is this a quiet building? How many units are in the building?
Is the rental in a quiet neighborhood?
- How far is the apartment to the nearest grocery store?
- Are there laundry facilities in the apartment building? If not,

TENANT RESPONSIBILITIES AND QUICK TIPS

- Find out if heating, electricity, and other utilities are included.
- You will need to pay double your first month (rent + damage deposit).
- Pay your rent on time.
- Keep the rental clean.
- Keep any provided items like a stove and fridge clean.
- Repair any damage that you or your guests have caused.
- Ensure that you or your guests do not create a disturbance or a nuisance (excessive noise).
- It is advisable to do an inspection with the landlord before signing the lease (if you aren't in the area, ask if they would be willing to do a video tour).
- Take pictures of the apartment prior to moving in and again when you are moving out. This way you will have a record of the conditions of the apartment at the time of move-in. This can help you get your full damage deposit back at the end of your lease, or at least ensure that you only pay for the damage you caused.
- Ensure all appliances are in working order, refrigerator, stove, heaters.
- Ensure all electrical outlets are working properly.
- Ensure all taps in kitchen and bathroom function properly.
- Ensure all locks on doors and windows and mailbox are working properly.
- Is there extra storage space available to tenants? Is parking available?
- Is there an extra fee for parking?

BASIC LANDLORD RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide a copy of the signed lease agreement to the tenant(s).
- Fulfill the terms and conditions of the lease agreement.
- To provide a rental unit that is safe, clean, and fit to live in.
- To provide a rental unit that is well maintained and meets all housing and building standards.
- To ensure common areas are safe and clean.
- Complete repairs and maintenance in a reasonable amount of time.
- Do not interrupt the supply of heat, water, or electric power services to the premises, except in an emergency.
- Provide proper notice for terminations, entry, rent increases etc.
- Respect the dignity and rights of tenants.

HEALTHCARE AND INSURANCE

GUARD.ME INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE

Guard.me insurance is mandatory for all international students studying at NBCC. International students will be charged the full amount of \$600 upfront and provided with a 12-month plan. Your Guard.me insurance plan enrollment will be processed following online registration.

Students with valid Medicare coverage for the duration of their academic program will be able to [opt-out](#) during the regular opt-out period at the beginning of their annual academic cycle. Students who successfully [opt out of the Guard.me](#) medical insurance plan is required to hold the Guard.me Excursion Plan. The cost of this plan and the coverage details are available on the [Guard.me](#) website.

If you arrive early, you can purchase additional insurance at NBCC's discounted rate by going to www.guard.me/nbcc/department/inbound/early-arrivals. International student's dependents (spouse and children) are not automatically covered by insurance. If you need insurance for your dependents, you can buy insurance at NBCC's discounted rate for each of them by going to www.guard.me/nbcc/dependents/inbound/dependents

HEALTH AND DENTAL INSURANCE

NBCCSU SUPPLEMENTAL HEALTH AND DENTAL INSURANCE (ALL STUDENTS)

Full-time students are automatically opted in and the plan is mandatory for students in NBCCSU's regular programs. Students who are new to the plan will have a validation period of between 45 and 60 days. During this time, benefits can be accessed but must be held until the validation period has passed. After the validation period, new students are activated to the plan.

Additional coverage for spouse and/or dependents is available. You will have one opportunity to purchase family coverage for your spouse and/or dependents by submitting an application form to the Student Benefits Representative.

Students may "opt-out" of this coverage upon provision of proof of alternate equivalent insurance coverage.

The deadline to opt-out of the Health and Dental Insurance or to purchase additional coverage for your spouse and/or dependents is:

Fall Term: Friday September 13th, 2024

Winter Term: Friday January 31st, 2025
