Q: I am in a one-year certificate program and have decided to enter the two-year diploma that will include my current program as the first year. What should I do for my study permit extension?

A: You should refer to the first question in this document and submit your study permit extension before November 1, 2024 if you have all paperwork associated with your transfer into the two-year program.

Q: I am in a one-year certificate program and have decided to apply for a second (different) one-year certificate program to begin in Fall 2025. What should I do for my study permit extension?

A: You should refer to the first question in this document and submit your study permit extension before November 1, 2024 if you have all paperwork associated with your second program of study.

If you do not have all paperwork associated with your second program of study, it is possible that it will not be possible to apply for a study permit extension before November 1.
